

TITLE 7 INDECENT EXPOSURE

**CHAPTER 7.01 INDECENT EXPOSURE OR SIMULATION THEREOF PROHIBITED;
LICENSEE'S DUTY TO PREVENT**

For the purpose of regulating the exposing of sexual parts of the human body, and protecting the public in those areas located within Brown County, the following Indecent Exposure or Simulation Thereof Ordinance is hereby adopted.

**Article I: INDECENT EXPOSURE OR SIMULATION THEREOF PROHIBITED; LICENSEE'S
DUTY TO PREVENT**

- A. It is unlawful for any person on premises licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages, which is to include a licensee authorized to sell low-point beer, while in the presence of any other person:
- (1) To fail to conceal, with a fully opaque covering, the sexual parts of his or her body, to include the genitals, pubic area and anus of any person, or the nipple and areola of the female breast;
 - (2) To expose any device, costume or covering which gives the appearance of, or simulates, the genitals or pubic area of the male or female body, or the nipple of the female breast.
- B. It is unlawful for any licensee in alcohol beverages, which is to include a licensee authorized to sell low-point beer, to cause, allow or permit any person on said licensed premises to violate the provisions of subsection (a) of this section.

Article II: SANCTIONS

Violations of this County Ordinance shall be deemed a Class 2 Misdemeanor.
