Purpose: *To provide a \$250.00 Scholarship to graduating 4-H senior members who will be furthering their education.*

To qualify, applicant must:

1. Be a high school graduate (can be a freshman in college);
2. Currently enrolled in 4-H;
3. Have been in 4-H three years with the last two years being consecutive;
4. Be graduating from 4-H;
5. Complete your 4-H year requirements; and
6. When the applicant goes to college, they must send the SDSU Extension/BC 4-H Office a Student Verification Letter, which is signed and has an official seal by the Dean of Registrar.

This is a one-time only scholarship to each applicant.
