Weed & Pest Department Monthly Update

The first round of ROW spraying is almost done, but the weather keeps putting us behind schedule. After we finish the first round of spraying, we have some other spraying jobs to complete before we start our 2nd round.

Mosquito Fogging is going full force right now and so far all of the accounts are on board each week. This week will be the last of the chemical we purchased with grant money, so this may affect how many communities continue with weekly spraying. The weather has also limited us to fogging on Tuesday 3 of the last 4 weeks. Spraying the same day each week can make adulticiding less effective, so we're hoping for a Thursday spray this week. Tyler Bierman gave an update on Aberdeen's mosquito control efforts and stated that the culex numbers are way up, and there have been several pools testing positive for West Nile disease.

Other Matters

Tyler Stadel from NRCS attended the meeting and answered some questions regarding CRP contracts, noxious weed control efforts, and enforcements on CRP. He was invited to tour some areas with the Weed & Pest department.

Duane Jark announced that he would be stepping down from the Weed & Pest Board. The Board thanked him for his many years of service and will begin looking for a replacement.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 16, 2025, at 11:30AM at the Weed & Pest shop at 10 North Congress St.
