1. **WILDFLOWERS** (noun) Flowers that grow in untended areas without care
2. **SURVIVE** (verb) To continue to live
3. **ECOSYSTEM** (noun) A community of nature (birds, plants, animals) that live in the same place.
4. **BOUNDARIES** (noun) Lines that define the size of something. A city block had boundaries (streets) on all four sides.
5. **PROCESS** (noun) Method of doing something.
6. **PLATTING** (verb) To map or organize land into blocks so people can purchase or rent a certain portion
7. **PLAT** (noun) A section of land that is part of a larger area. The original PLAT of Aberdeen consisted of 16 blocks.
8. **IDENTIFY** (verb) To recognize. I can identify my coat in the cloak room.
9. **POPULATION** (noun) The number of people living in a place. The population of Aberdeen today is about 25,000
10. **EXPANDED** (verb) Made larger.
11. **FESTIVALS** (noun) Special programs or events
12. **CEREMONY** (noun) An activity that is very formal and structured. The wedding ceremony will be next Tuesday.
